FEES AND PAYMENT

FEES

The fee for one Super Summer classes is \$195. For example, if your child enrolls in a morning or afternoon class only, the fee for the session is \$195. Each class after the first (up to 3) is an additional \$170 per class. For example, if a student enrolls in a morning and an afternoon class in a given session or for a morning class in both sessions, the cost would be \$365 (\$195 + \$170).

PAYMENT

Checks should be made payable to Purdue University. Tuition also may be charged to Discover, VISA, or MasterCard if registering online.

An introductory packet, containing information about your child's class placement, will be mailed the week prior to the start of the program. If you do not receive notice at least three days prior to your child's first class, call our office, 765-494-7243, to check class assignment and location.

FINANCIAL AID

A limited number of need-based scholarships for partial tuition are available. To apply, complete and return the financial aid form on page 18 with your child's application. Financial aid applications must be faxed or postmarked by 5 p.m. on Monday, April 13. You will receive notification of award by Monday, April 27.
